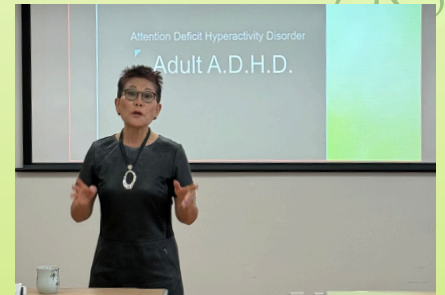
## Welcome, Richard & Natalie!
