

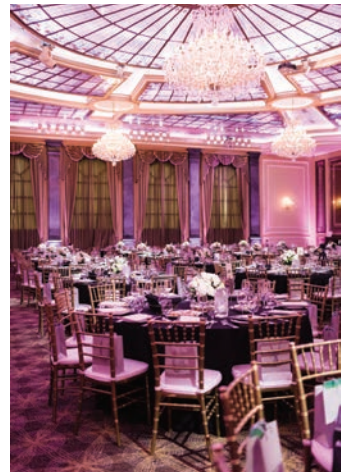

Dear KFAM Friends,

We are pleased to present our 2018 Annual Report.

It was a stressful year, as we tried to assuage the fears of our immigrant clients and develop the right tools to support them during this xenophobic political climate. We also faced the daily image of homeless encampments springing up all around our Koreatown office, with the reminder that for those who seek KFAM’s core services—domestic violence, mental health and child welfare—lack of safety net services and support can lead to this outcome.

KFAM responded by doubling down on our effort to provide critical services to our vulnerable community members. Our staff grew by more than 20% over the course of one year. We celebrated our 35th Anniversary with a black tie gala for 500+ guests. We launched our *Project Sori* sexual assault program, capitalizing on the success of the #MeToo and #TimesUp movements that spread through US and Korea (and beyond). Under our new Domestic Violence (DV) Housing First, we provided rental support and other financial assistance to stabilize housing for 35 Korean immigrant DV survivors.

We expanded our Asian Foster Family Initiative to work with Korean, Chinese and Filipino foster children and families. We also started a new Tobacco Prevention campaign, targeting API communities in the South Bay and San Gabriel Valley to strengthen anti-secondhand smoke ordinances.

Our Counseling Department provided not only 298 clients with therapy, case management, and psychiatric medication support, but also educated another 1,187 community members on mental health and wellness. And we continue to ensure over 4,000 children receive healthy meals and snacks through our Child Care Food Program.

We hope you enjoy reading more about what we accomplished in 2018 and thank you for your support.

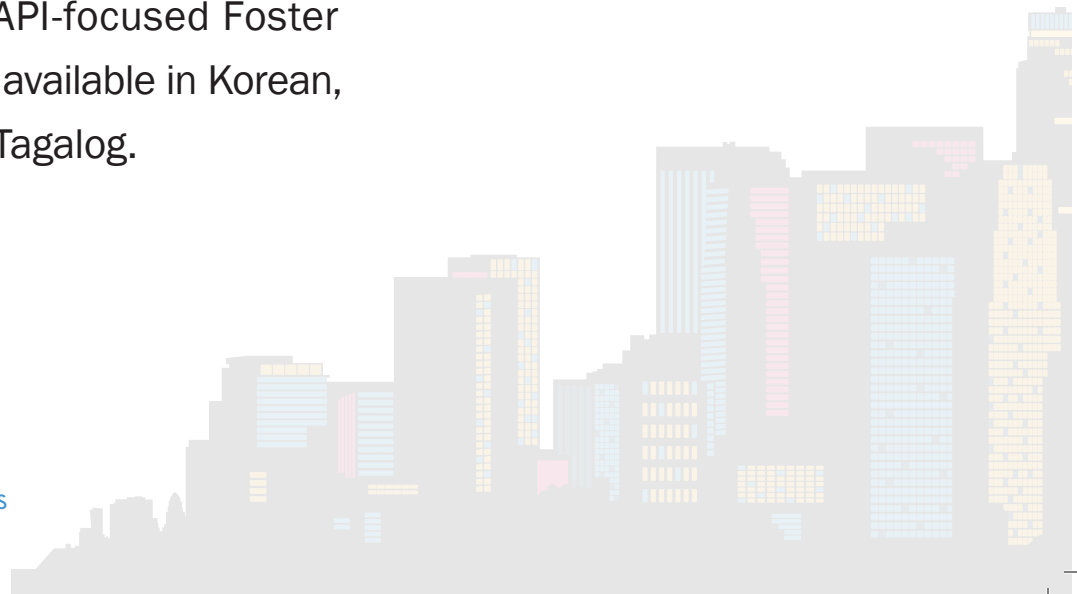

Asian Foster Family Initiative

The Asian Foster Family Initiative (AFFI) recruits and trains Asian Pacific Islander (API) resource (foster) families to provide culturally-sensitive homes to API foster children. AFFI operates the nation's first and only API-focused Foster Family Agency with services available in Korean, Mandarin, Cantonese, and Tagalog.





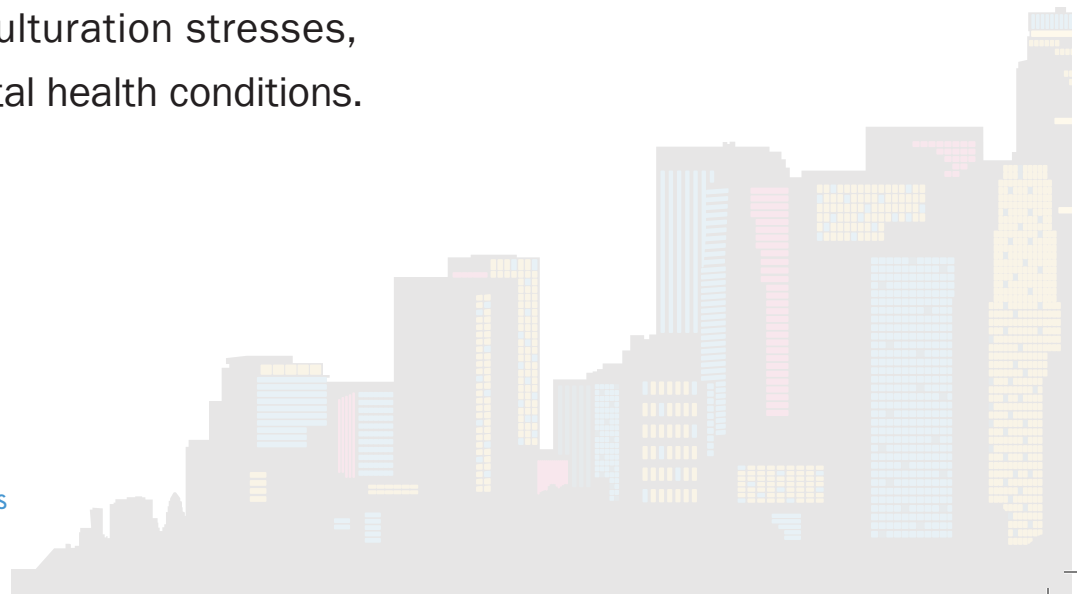
Domestic Violence Program

KFAM's Domestic Violence program provides those who experience gender-based violence such as domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking with Korean bilingual/bicultural crisis intervention, counseling, financial support, and culturally-specific education and outreach. We work with survivors and exposed children, as well as providing perpetrator accountability group programs.



Clinical Counseling Program

KFAM's Korean bilingual/bicultural therapists offer individuals, couples, and families with private counseling sessions, psychiatric medication support and group classes to help with relationship problems, parent-child conflicts, acculturation stresses, depression, and other mental health conditions.





Child and Adult Wellness Program

KFAM's Child and Adult Wellness Program provides individuals with the tools, education, support, and resources to meet their diverse needs and enhance their quality of life. Services include our Child Care Food Program, Tobacco Prevention Campaign, and senior yoga classes.



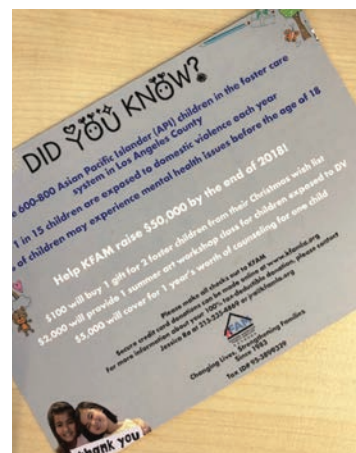
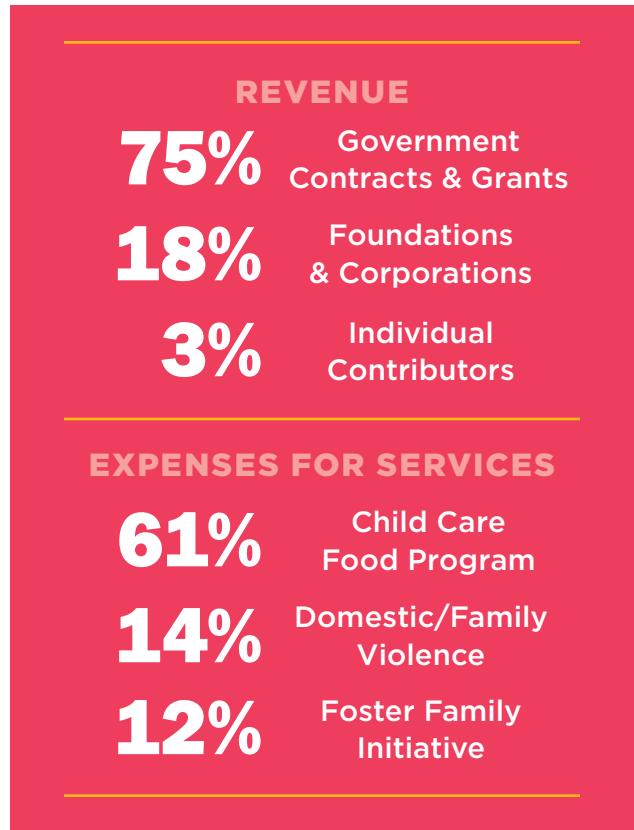
