KFAM is seeking a part-time (10-15 hours) Licensed Clinical Social Worker or Licensed Marriage Family Therapist to serve as Clinical Supervisor for our Asian Foster Family Initiative (AFFI) Programs. The individual will provide clinical supervision to ACSW, AMFT, and MFT trainees to support and help implement state grant programs.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

- Oversee quality of services, including accuracy, timeliness, productivity, and compliance with State grant
- Approve submitted notes by clinicians and MFT trainees within 48 hours
- Support and make decisions with the Program Manager for the AFFI Department regarding grant program
- Review clinical records including treatment plans, goals, interventions and etc.
- Ensure quality of service through chart review, peer review, program evaluations, and related activities
- Provide individual and group supervision for clinical staff as well as crisis intervention consultation
- Promote the development of counseling skills and approaches
- Other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

- CA License in Clinical Social Work or Marriage and Family Therapist (LCSW or LMFT), required
- A minimum of **5 years** clinical experience, required
- Completion of Clinical Supervisor CEU per BBS regulation, required
- Experience in program planning, program development and implementation, and program evaluation a plus
- Knowledge and/or experience in working with API community a plus.
