



KOREAN SPEAKING GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE VICTIM ADVOCATE (FULL-TIME)

JOB DESCRIPTION: Korean American Family Services (KFAM) is a non-profit organization specializing in gender-based violence, mental health, and social services to Korean immigrant families. KFAM is seeking a ***Korean speaking*** victim advocate to work under the supervision of the Gender-based Violence (GBV) Program Manager and GBV Direct Service Supervisor. The family advocate is responsible for providing prevention services for Korean community members in various settings.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

Direct Services:

- Provide intake and assessment of needs; crisis intervention; and safety planning as needed
- Advocate on behalf of clients and/or their children to government agencies, courts, schools, and other service providers as needed
- Participate in rotation for handling after-hours GBV hotline calls
- Work with GBV direct service supervisor to develop treatment plan and deliver appropriate direct services as needed

Program Development and Outreach:

- Utilize Triple P: Positive Parenting Program in order to provide culturally tailored parenting education for Korean immigrant parents in various settings (individual, group)
- Be able to work with Korean faith community for outreach/training
- Assist with outreach events, represent agency at meetings/conferences, and network with service providers, as needed
- Work in teams with GBV and administrative staff to carry out community education and trainings
- Assist in keeping list of community resources current

QUALIFICATIONS:

- ***Must speak Korean fluently.*** English language ability (speaking, reading and writing), a plus.
- Experience working in GBV field, a strong plus.
- Experience providing parenting to Korean immigrant population, a strong plus
- Experience working with Korean immigrant populations, especially women, a plus.
- Ability to work some evenings and Saturday mornings, as needed.
- Well-organized, self-directed, highly-motivated, and hard-working.
- Must have driver's license, insurance and be willing to drive, as needed.
