



KOREAN SPEAKING GENDER BASED VIOLENCE VICTIM ADVOCATE (FULL-TIME)

JOB DESCRIPTION: Korean American Family Services (KFAM) is a non-profit organization specializing in family violence, mental health, and social services to Korean immigrant families. KFAM is seeking a ***Korean speaking*** victim advocate to work under the supervision of the Gender Based Violence (GBV) Program Manager. The victim advocate is responsible for community organizing, coalition-building with community/faith leaders, training, and prevention education. S/he will also develop public awareness materials, conduct media outreach, and organize camping trips with male community/faith leaders and youth.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

Program Development and Outreach:

- Work closely with male community/faith leaders and youth to educate and train them on gender-based violence
- Plan and coordinate education events with male community/faith leaders and youth
- Create DV-related educational resources in Korean and English.
- Recruit and train Korean male mentors/coaches for prevention education.
- Maintain documentation and produce reports of all program activities and ensure compliance with requirements.
- Assist with outreach events, represent agency at meetings/conferences, and network with service providers, as needed.
- Work in teams with GBV, outreach and administrative staff to carry out public awareness and trainings.

Direct Services:

- Support other victim advocates with case management and GBV counseling as needed.
- Other duties as needed

QUALIFICATIONS:

- ***Must speak English fluently.*** Korean reading and writing a plus.
- Experience working in DV field or with other victims of crime a strong plus.
- Experience working with Korean immigrant populations, especially men or faith leaders, a plus.
- Ability to work some evenings and Saturday mornings, as needed.
- Well-organized, self-directed, highly-motivated, and hard-working.
- Must have driver's license, insurance and be willing to drive, as needed.
